In this month's "Inside the Profession," Rebecca Berg examines growing skepticism about science, particularly health science as it relates to food, and environmental health's potential in addressing this concern. As our cover points out, science and technology allow food to be more processed than ever before. Using the raw milk controversy as a starting point, Berg informally surveys both lay people's and EH professionals' views on science, the food industry, and government. She also investigates the intertwining of health science, government agencies, and corporations and the negative ramifications this interconnection has on consumers. While this topic is complex and controversial, Berg notes that opportunities may exist for EH professionals on several fronts: as educators, communicators, advocates, and even as fellow skeptics.
