



Nomination

Second Vice President

The Second Vice President is an officer on the Board of Directors and a member of the Affiliate Council of the National Environmental Health Association. This national officer moves in succession from Second Vice President to First Vice President to President- elect to President to Immediate Past President.

The candidate must:

- Be an Active or Life member of NEHA for at least three years prior to taking office
- Remain an Active or Life member during their term of office
- Be nominated by five NEHA **voting** members from the candidates' region in which three of the five members represent different affiliates
- Be qualified according to the Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws and are willing to faithfully serve

Submission

To submit your nomination, provide the following:

- This completed form
- Resume
- Headshot
- Member Signature Form with at least 5 qualifying signatures

Email the completed form, resume, headshot, and Member Signature Form to the Board of Directors Nomination Committee liaison at nehaelections@neha.org.

Deadline

All materials must be received by the Board of Directors Nomination Committee no later than December 1 the year prior to the year the candidate is being considered for nomination.

If you are accepted, you will be placed on the Spring Ballot. Successful candidates will begin their three-year terms of office at the Annual Educational Conference (AEC) & Exhibition following the election.
