Audience	This course is designed for federal, state, tribal, territorial, local, and international regulatory officials who are responsible for application reviews and inspections of temporary food establishments.
Description	The purpose of this course is to prepare participants to effectively conduct an application review, menu review, and inspection of a temporary food establishment (TFE) and institute corrective actions. Emphasis is placed on the proper design and location of food storage, preparation and serving operations and sanitary facilities. This course will cover the key elements for conducting application reviews, menu reviews, and inspections of TFEs. Key steps for planning a national special security event or other large-scale special events are also covered. Methods of instruction include lectures with hands-on group exercises and discussion to reinforce performance-level concepts.
