ABOUT THE COVER



Rapid proliferation of hydraulic fracturing ("fracking") facilities has led to concerns about human exposure to airborne pollutants, notably fine par-

ticulates (P $M_{2.5}$, particles with a diameter of 2.5 µm and smaller) and crystalline silica (quartz). Fine particulates have been identified by U.S. EPA as a cause of cardiovascular and lung disease including lung cancer. In our cover feature this month, "P $M_{2.5}$ Airborne Particulates Near Frac Sand Operations," the authors describe their first-of-its-kind pilot study to measure P $M_{2.5}$ around frac sand mines. Five of the six study sites had P $M_{2.5}$ levels above the U.S. EPA annual standard of 12 µg/m³.
